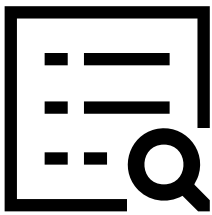

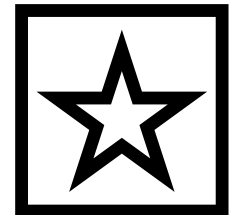

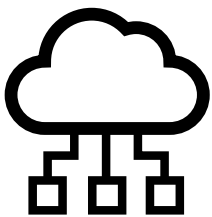

# ClassIT+ Overview

---

## **Q. Will ClassIT+ replace the current ClassIT?**

**A.** Yes, ClassIT+ is replacing ClassIT and is the only online tool designed to help you navigate the NMFC changes in Docket 2025-1 and beyond.

## **Q. Will the current ClassIT be available after the release of ClassIT+?**

**A.** We will continue to support the current ClassIT for at least 90 days after the release of ClassIT+. However, please note that ClassIT+ is the only tool designed to help you navigate the NMFC changes in Docket 2025-1, which is effective on July 19, 2025. This means that you will not have access to the Docket 2025-1 data until you transition to the new ClassIT+.

## **Q. Will there be different versions of ClassIT+ based on features (i.e., beginner v. advanced)?**

**A.** No, not for this first release on July 15, 2025. In the future, we will be providing additional tiers focusing on more advanced features. This first release of ClassIT+ is considered the basic or foundation package and is the new standard in classification management.

## **Q. Will ClassIT+ allow concurrent logins so we can share one login?**

**A.** No, ClassIT+ will not allow concurrent logins. We strongly encourage each user of ClassIT+ to have their own login credentials to reinforce our authentication process and ensure secure access for each user.

**Q. What browsers will be supported for ClassIT+?**

**A.** We will support Chrome, Firefox, Edge, and Safari.

**Q. Will there be a ClassIT+ app for mobile devices, such as smartphones and tablets?**

**A.** No, there will not be a designated ClassIT+ app. ClassIT+ is specifically designed to be adaptable and responsive on any device, making it easy to access ClassIT+ from anywhere and without losing any of its features. You'll have the same performance, the same usability, and the same access just from a different device.

**Q. What technical stack are you embracing to build ClassIT+?**

**A.** We are leveraging the Azure technology stack and their cloud-first approach, providing us with the latest technologies to ensure an uninterrupted presence and giving us access to benefits such as autoscaling, caching for speed, and no single points of failure.

**Q. When will ClassIT+ be released and what are some of the key dates prior to this?**

**A.** ClassIT+ will be released on July 15, 2025. Key dates include:

- February 12, 2025: ClassIT+ contracts and license agreements available for review.
- February 25, 2025: ClassIT+ Application Programming Interface (API) documentation and connection testing against Sandbox available.
- May 13, 2025: Beta testing starts with select customers. In addition, Sandbox is available for API testing.
- July 15, 2025: Release of ClassIT+.
- July 19, 2025: Effective date of NMFC Docket 2025-1.

# Current ClassIT Users

---

**Q. We just renewed our subscription, will there be an opportunity to upgrade to ClassIT+ or do I have to wait until the current one is expired?**

**A.** Current subscribers do not have to wait until the end of their current subscription before upgrading to the new ClassIT+. In fact, we strongly encourage current subscribers to transition to the new ClassIT+ prior to the end of their current subscription so they can access the most up-to-date NMFC data.

**Q. If I am a current ClassIT user, do I need to sign up for the new ClassIT+?**

**A.** We will be providing guidance for transitioning your current subscription to ClassIT+. Please see [classitplus.com](https://classitplus.com) for more information.

**Q. Will the current ClassIT be updated with the changes in NMFC Docket 2025-1?**

**A.** No, the current ClassIT will not be updated with the changes in 2025-1. ClassIT+ is the only tool designed to help you access and navigate the NMFC changes in 2025-1 and beyond.

**Q. How long will the current ClassIT be available?**

**A.** ClassIT will continue to be available for at least 90 days after the release of ClassIT+ so you can easily transition over to the new application and NMFC changes.

**Q. Will our current company settings and assigned licenses be transferred over to ClassIT+?**

**A.** We will be providing guidance for transitioning your current subscription to ClassIT+. Please see [classitplus.com](https://classitplus.com) for more information.

**Q. Will our search history automatically get switched from ClassIT to ClassIT+?**

**A.** No, your search history from the current ClassIT will not be transferred over to the new ClassIT+. Tracking and managing search history is only available in ClassIT+.

**Q. Will the current NMFC DDS subscription be available with ClassIT+?**

**A.** Our current NMFC Data Distribution Service (DDS) subscription will no longer be available in 2025. We will be offering a new and more robust ClassIT+ API to replace the NMFC DDS. # ClassIT+ Features

---

**Q. Will we be able to search using “as of” a previous date?**

**A.** Yes, we will continue to offer the ability to search the NMFC content as of a specific date. In addition, you'll be able to search NMFC Supplements and Public Dockets to see when changes were proposed and their effective date.

**Q. Will ClassIT+ include a calculator for density?**

**A.** Yes, ClassIT+ will include a calculator for density.

**Q. Is the calculator only for density or will the Item 680 calculators be available as well?**

**A.** We will have both a density calculator and three Item 680 calculators, one for Note 2(A), Note 2(B), and Note 2(C) respectively.

**Q. Other than my search history, is there a way to find items that I always look for and use?**

**A.** Yes, ClassIT+ gives you the ability to mark items as your favorite so you can easily find them. You'll also be able to add bookmarks to key sections of the online version of the NMFC Book so you can quickly find information on packaging rules, etc.

**Q. Can I email or print an item's details to share with others?**

**A.** Yes, you'll be able to easily email and/or print an item's details. In addition, for those companies with multiple subscribers, your team will be able to easily share favorites, synonyms, and comments with each other and access via a centralized dashboard.

**Q. Will there be a way to clear search history?**

**A.** Yes, you'll be able to manage and clear your search history.

**Q. Will we still be able to view details on packaging requirements for applicable NMFC items?**

**A.** Yes, you will still be able to view additional details on packaging requirements.

**Q. Would we be able to print or download individual NMFC numbers?**

**A.** Yes, you will be able to print or email individual NMFC numbers and their details so you can easily share with customers.



# ClassIT+ API

---

**Q. Will the API be included with our ClassIT+ subscription or is it an additional cost?**

**A.** The ClassIT+ API is not included in your ClassIT+ subscription; however, if you purchase the ClassIT+ API, then you automatically receive one (1) license for ClassIT+ so you can manage your API subscription.

**Q. Will documentation and sample requests be available for the new ClassIT+ API?**

**A.** Yes, we will provide API documentation and Software Development Kits (SDKs). Preview of the API documentation will be available on February 25, 2025.

**Q. Will there be a Sandbox available so we can test the new ClassIT+ API and our connection?**

**A.** Yes, we will have a Sandbox available for testing the new ClassIT+ API. Starting February 25, 2025, you will be able to test your connection. Starting May 13, 2025, you will be able to fully test the API and its features.

**Q. Will there be a new API/web service license agreement?**

**A.** Yes, we will have a complete transition process for our existing ClassIT API subscribers so you can specify your intent to migrate over to the new ClassIT+ API and agree to our new license agreement.

**Q. Should we anticipate significant changes to the basic structure of the Classification data itself (e.g., Item & Description > Sub & Description > Class)?**

**A.** No, there will not be any significant changes to the basic structure of the Classification data.

**Q. Do you anticipate supporting any batch-related methods with the API, or only one individual search at a time?**

**A.** The original intention is to provide singular responses for most scenarios so you can retrieve precisely what you are seeking while enabling us to maintain high availability and rapid response times. However, there is potential that we will provide batch responses for specific cases.

**Q. We perform our updates after the NMFC Docket is approved and the weekend before the Supplement goes into effect. Will this still be possible with the new API?**

**A.** Yes, the updates will be available for implementation 7 days prior to the effective date.

**Q. How does the API address risks related to inaccurate or outdated NMFC data being accessed in real-time?**

**A.** Both the ClassIT+ website and API will pull from the same set of underlying data. This means that there will be no disconnect between what is displayed in one or the other. Both will pull from the same source that has been vetted through our well-established review and approval process, ensuring the most up-to-date and accurate data.

**Q. If we have a density-based item, and we know the NMFC code and density of that item, can we retrieve the freight class through the API?**

**A.** Yes, there will be calls where we'll return more detailed information such as items, item numbers, and all the density subs. If you know the item number and you know the density, you'll be able to see the subs and pair them up with the class that matches that density.

**Q. Do you have carriers who will use the API to integrate with freight bill entry systems or is this a standalone tool to support rate or customer service employees?**

**A.** Yes, we do and expect more carriers to use the ClassIT+ API to integrate with their freight bill entry system.

**Q. Can I integrate ClassIT+ with my TMS?**

**A.** We do not have any details available regarding native integration with TMS providers. **Q. Can I integrate ClassIT+ with barcode scanners?**

**A.** We do not have any details available regarding native integration with barcode scanners.

**Q. How does the NMFTA plan to adapt the ClassIT+ API to accommodate existing and emerging compliance requirements?**

**A.** ClassIT+ is designed with flexibility and scalability in mind, enabling it to easily adapt to emerging compliance requirements. By incorporating modular frameworks and regular updates, the system can quickly integrate new compliance protocols as they arise, ensuring that our operations stay ahead of evolving standards.

# NMFC Classification

---

**Q. Will the sub-density classes be the same across the board for all items?**

- A.** As a part of Docket 2025-1 strategy, the Freight Classification Development Council (FCDC) 11-sub density scale will be expanded to 13-subprovisions.
- Sub 11 will be amended to apply to densities ranging from 30 but less than 35 pcf and be assigned class 60.
  - Sub 12 will apply on densities ranging from 35 but less than 50 pcf and be assigned class 55.
  - Sub 13 will apply on densities of 50 pcf or greater and be assigned class 50.

**Q. For those of us with concerns on how density is determined and defined by the NMFC, will carriers who are members be required to use the NMFC density definitions as to how the class will be determined?**

- A.** The NMFC is a voluntary standard that carriers, shippers, and third-party logistics providers (3PLs) use when assigning class. While it is voluntary, it is the standard and, as such, should be used if class is being determined absent any tariffs the carrier may have published, etc. In 2025, we will be making density the primary factor when evaluating freight; however, it will still be important to have the correct item # since items that have handling, stowability, or liability concerns will not be full density.

**Q. If a shipper is having difficulty identifying their NMFC code, is there an Interpretations portal or process for the shipper to submit an inquiry to the NMFTA for assistance?**
