### **Know Your Shipper Profile**

- □ Review the updated National Motor Freight Classification (NMFC®) list Check if your products are being affected by the changes. Visit <a href="https://info.nmfta.org/2025-nmfc-changes#resources">https://info.nmfta.org/2025-nmfc-changes#resources</a>.
- ☐ **Understand your shipping process** Identify inefficiencies in your shipping workflow.
- ☐ **Review your packaging**Is your less-than-truckload (LTL) freight as dense and compact as possible?

#### **Provide Accurate Information**

- ☐ Make recording the dimensions of your shipping units mandatory This will be key to getting the proper class.
- ☐ Record handling unit dimensions on the bill of lading (BOL) Ensure weight and dimensions are listed correctly.

#### **Have a Dialogue with Your Carriers**

- ☐ Understand how different LTL carriers operate

  Not all LTL networks are the same, and classification rules may vary slightly.
- Ask how you can improve your freight stowability
  Your handling units should maximize trailer space efficiency.
- ☐ What info do LTL carriers have about your freight?

  Can they give some insight on if the changes affect your freight?
