Subject: Important Notice: Non-Class 8 SCAC Reseller Program Ending February 26, 2026

To Our Valued SCAC Customer,

This notice is being sent by the National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc. (NMFTA)™ in partnership with your SCAC reseller to ensure you have clear and accurate information about upcoming changes to the SCAC program.

The National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc. (NMFTA)™ is writing to inform you of an important upcoming change to how Standard Carrier Alpha Code® (SCAC®) applications and renewals are processed for non-class 8 carriers.

Effective **February 26, 2026**, NMFTA will implement a verification process for SCAC applications and renewals for non-Class 8 carriers and become the **sole issuer of all SCACs for non-Class 8 carriers**. After this date, all SCAC applications and renewals will be handled **directly by NMFTA** through NMFTA's official SCAC application, scaccode.com.

Please note, there are no changes for Class 8 carriers at this time.

This change is part of NMFTA's broader effort to streamline SCAC administration, enhance data accuracy, and ensure the most secure and consistent customer experience possible.

What This Means for You

- Until **February 26, 2026**, you may continue to apply for or renew your SCAC through your current reseller.
- Beginning **February 26, 2026**, all SCAC applications and renewals for non-class 8 carriers must be completed directly through NMFTA's official SCAC application, scaccode.com. **If you are a Class 8 carrier, your current process remains unchanged.**
- NMFTA will provide clear instructions and resources in advance of this transition to ensure a smooth process.

Why NMFTA Is Making This Change

For more than 50 years, the SCAC has served as the industry's standard carrier identifier, supporting efficient and reliable operations across transportation and logistics.

Centralizing SCAC processing under NMFTA will allow for greater consistency, faster service, and a unified point of contact for all carriers.

What You Need to Do Now

No immediate action is required. You may continue working with your current SCAC reseller until the transition date. NMFTA will contact all customers in early 2026 with next steps and renewal guidance.
