Subject X: China Group

**Quick View:** Three items related to ceramicware, china, earthenware, porcelain, or stoneware are canceled with reference to item 47500, which provides classes predicated on the FCDC’s 13-sub density scale.

- China Group, item 47490, canceled with no further application

**LIMITATION OF CARRIER LIABILITY WHERE VALUE IS NOT DECLARED BY SHIPPER**

Where item 47500, 88160, 100240, 164900, or 168960 of this Classification applies, and shipper fails to declare a value as required by those provisions, the shipment will not be accepted, but if the shipment is inadvertently accepted, the carrier's liability shall be limited as follows:

**LIMITATION OF CARRIER LIABILITY WHERE VALUE IS NOT DECLARED BY SHIPPER**

Where item ~~⇨47500~~, 88160, 100240, 164900, or 168960 of this Classification applies, and shipper fails to declare a value as required by those provisions, the shipment will not be accepted, but if the shipment is inadvertently accepted, the carrier's liability shall be limited as follows:

Analysis

**Introduction**

This proposal was initially discussed by the FCDC at its public meeting on March 10, 2026, in Savannah, GA. During that meeting, comments were made suggesting the 13-subprovision density scale would be appropriate for the involved items. These items were initially reviewed with the intent of removing value-based provisions, combining like commodities, and examining the involved products' transportation characteristics. As a result, the FCDC voted to withdraw disposition of this proposal pending further review.

**Transportation Characteristics**

**Handling, Stowability and Liability**—While there have been reports on the involved products' inherent fragility, there appears to be no significant handling, stowability or liability issues when tendered with proper interior and exterior packaging.

**SUBJECT XX****Conclusion**

Based on the foregoing analysis, this proposal identifies density as the primary transportation characteristic and would cancel items 47495, 47545, and 47550 with reference to item 47500, naming “Ceramicware, China, Earthenware, Porcelain or Stoneware, NOI,” which provides classes predicated on the FCDC’s standard 13-subprovision density scale<sup>1</sup>.

Additionally, the China Group, item 47490, and Note, item 47501 would be canceled with no further application.

The FCDC’s Lead Classification and Packaging Analyst has reviewed the proposed minimum packaging requirements and determined they are appropriate for the LTL environment. A new packaging Note would also be established to provide additional packaging requirements.

Concurrently, Item (Rule) 172 would be amended to remove reference to item 47500.
