Analysis

Introduction

Five items in the Fish Group, as shown in the Present Classification Provisions herein, name particular types of fresh or frozen fish or shellfish, and these provisions can be difficult to interpret, apply, or verify.

Transportation Characteristics

Handling, Stowability, and Liability—For the involved commodities that are not frozen, there have been no reports of unusual or significant handling, stowability, or liability issues. Therefore, density has been identified as the primary transportation characteristic.

Conclusion

Based on the foregoing analysis, items 69720, 69730, 69750, and 69870 would be canceled with reference to the full-scale, density-based provisions of item 73260¹, and item 69770 would be canceled with reference to both items 73225² and 73260¹. Concurrently, the descriptions in both items 73225 and 73260 would be amended accordingly. Furthermore, Note, item 69774 would be canceled with no further application.

Additionally, the Fish Group, item 69700, would be canceled with no further application.

The FCDC's Lead Classification and Packaging Analyst has reviewed the proposed minimum packaging requirements and determined they are appropriate for the LTL environment. Moreover, a new Note attendant to item 73260 would be established to provide additional packaging requirements.
