Analysis

Introduction

Forty items in the Drugs, Medicines, Toilet Preparations or Personal Care Products Group, as shown in the Present Classification Provisions herein, name particular types of medicines or personal care products, and these provisions can be difficult to interpret, apply, or verify.

Transportation Characteristics

Density—Overall, the information of record includes 83,499 density figures, which were obtained from FCDC’s Density Study¹.

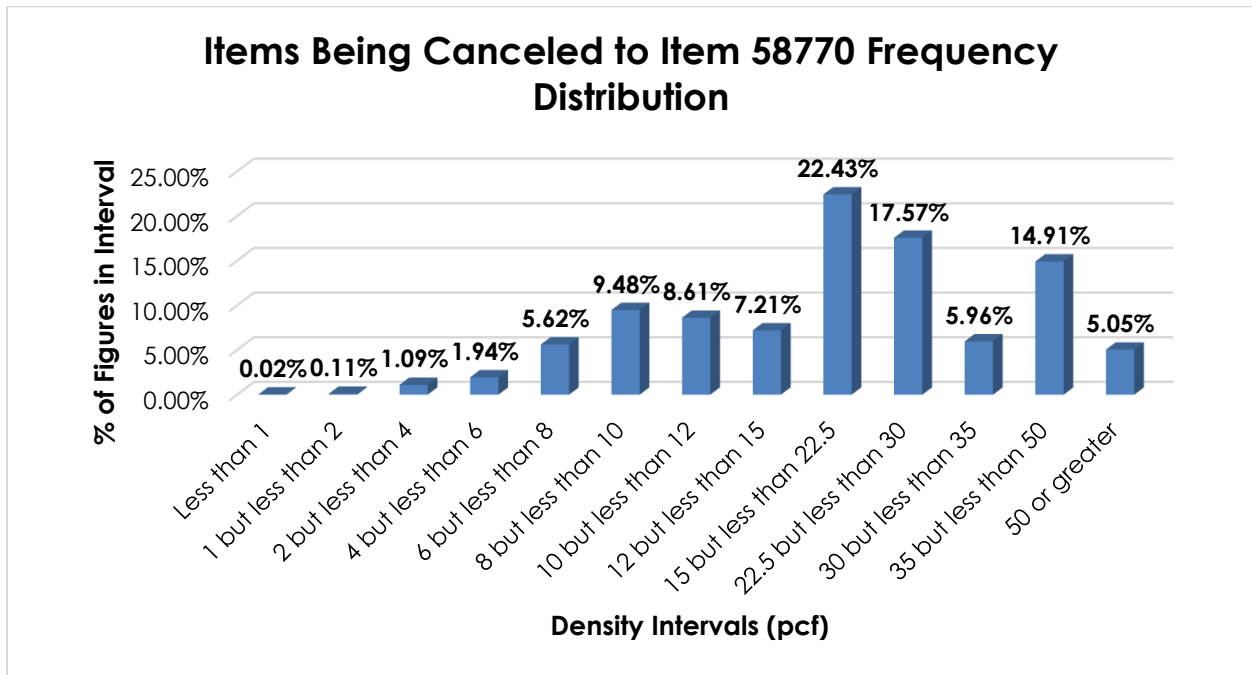
The graphs on the following pages show the frequency distributions for the proposed provisions.

¹ The Density Study is part of an ongoing effort by the FCDC to collect information on actual shipments across all product categories handled by the LTL industry. Carriers that choose to participate in the Study periodically submit shipment data captured through their respective freight auditing programs. The FCDC uses verifiable data points, identified by NMFC item, that include the weight and the dimensions and/or cube of the shipping unit.

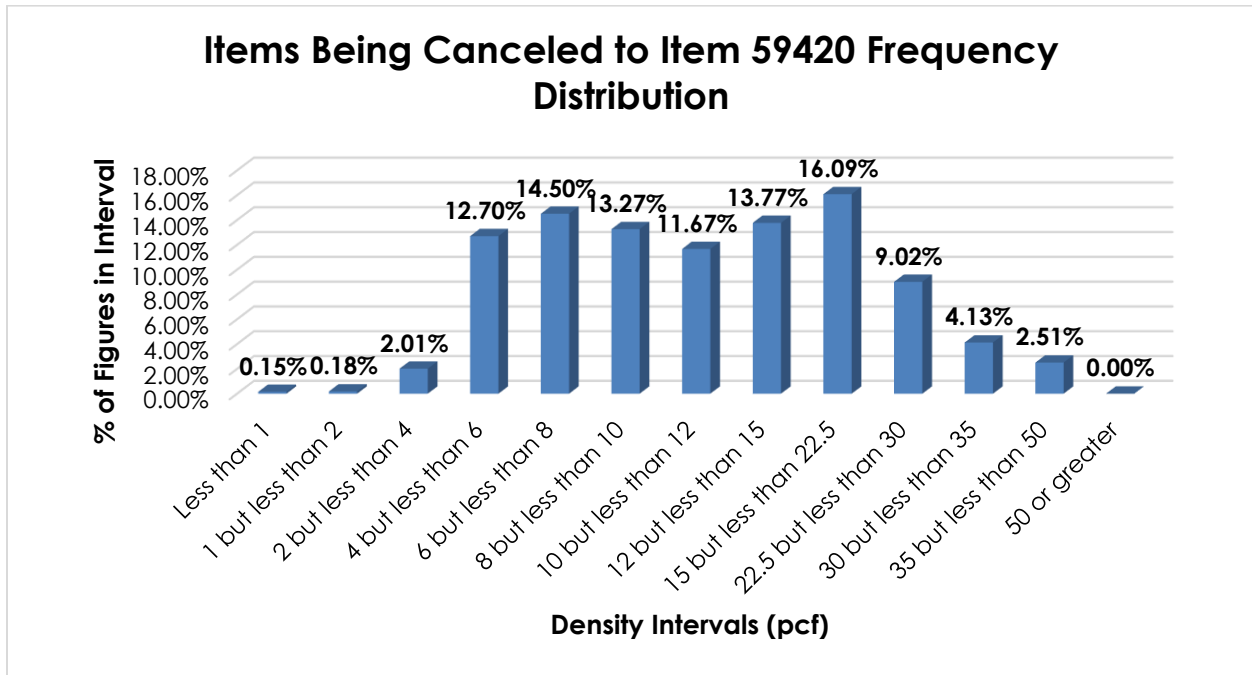
The information of record on commodities moving under items 58520, 58580, 58610, 58650, 58670, 58690, 58710, 58730, 58840, 58860, 58880, 58980, 59100, 59140, 59240, 59250, 59260, 59280, 59300, 59370, 59380, and 59480 includes 26,849 density observations. The densities range from 0.34 to 66.19 pcf, with an overall average density of 23.18 pcf. As shown in the graph below, the densities are distributed throughout the range, with a distinct peak in the 15 but less than 22.5 pcf interval.



Toilet Preparations or Personal Care Products

The information of record on commodities moving under items 58540, 58660, 58680, 58695, 58700, 58810, 58890, 58893, 58900, 59070, 59080, 59890, 59200, 59220, 59365, 59410, 59413, 59440, and 59460, includes 56,650 density observations. The densities range from 0.05 to 47.91 pcf, with an overall average density of 13.63 pcf. As shown in the graph on the following page, the densities are distributed throughout the range.

Handling, Stowability and Liability—

Drugs or Medicines, NOI

Care must be taken to avoid stowing the involved commodities with hazardous materials or other freight that may pose a contamination risk. They may also be damaged by freight with which stowed or by the elements. However, there have been no reports of unusual or significant handling, stowability, or liability issues.

Toilet Preparations or Personal Care Products

There have been no reports of unusual or significant handling, stowability or liability issues.

Conclusion

Based on the foregoing analysis, this proposal would cancel Items 58520, 58580, 58610, 58650, 58670, 58690, 58710, 58730, 58840, 58860, 58880, 58980, 59100, 59140, 59250, 59260, 59280, 59300, 59370, 59380, and 59480 with reference to the full-scale, density-based provisions of item 58770².

² Items 58770 and 59420 provide the FCDC’s 13-subprovision density scale, which includes reference to Item (Rule) 170, the inadvertence clause.

Additionally, items 58540, 58660, 58680, 58695, 58700, 58810, 58890, 58893, 58900, 59070, 59080, 59890, 59200, 59220, 59365, 59410, 59413, 59440, and 59460 would be canceled with reference to the full-scale, density-based provisions of item 59420⁹, and the "viz." listing would be amended accordingly. Notes, items 58891 and 58894 would be canceled and reestablished attendant to item 59420 to clarify the application of articles in the "viz."

Item 59310 would be canceled and reestablished as a stand-alone item and not subject to a generic heading. Currently, item 59310 is assigned a single class predicated on unusual or significant handling, stowability, and/or liability considerations. To highlight these issues, the FCDC proposes to add the "👉" symbol to the new item. The description and class assignment of the involved item would remain unchanged. Note, item 59312 would be canceled and reestablished attendant to this new item.

Furthermore, subgeneric heading 59240 and Notes, items 58542, 58692, 58812, 59367, and 59371 would be canceled with no further application.

The FCDC's Packaging Development Manager has reviewed the proposed minimum packaging requirements and determined they are appropriate for the LTL environment.
