Analysis and Conclusion

This proposal is a result of a review of items 49987 and 55410, naming various types of currency. To foster clarification and simplification, and to alleviate potential interpretive issues, this proposal would cancel items 49987 and 55410 with reference to a new item, naming “Currency, NOI, including Bank Bills, Coins or Notes.” Additionally, Note, item 49988 would be canceled and reestablished as a new Note attendant to the new item.
